Service Area(s): Citizen of the United States 60 years of age or older or a veteran of any age whose legal residence is Alexander, Franklin, Gallatin, Hardin, Jackson, Johnson, Massac, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Saline, Union, or Williamson County is eligible for legal assistance through the Legal Clinic.

The program provides civil legal services to those 60 and over or a veteran of any age. In general, these services consist of Powers of Attorney for Health Care & Property, Will preparation, Deeds, and Minor and Adult Guardianships.

The clinic also assists families of those who are no longer able to care for themselves or their property with the difficult issues arising out of the need for guardianship. Attorneys and law students from the Legal Clinic provide educational and informative presentations to senior citizens on legal matters of concern to older persons. Those not accepted as clients may still benefit from the educational programs provided each year.
